#### We Do Not Need to Mail Yearbooks to State Officers?

Following the recent approval by the voting members of Convention 2015, all 2015-2016 local chapter yearbooks MUST be UPLOADED to the Texas state website instead of mailing ten copies, as has been required in the past.

All of the requirements for yearbook contents and instructions for uploading PDF or Microsoft Word documents are found on the website at <a href="https://www.peotexas.org">www.peotexas.org</a> Login > locate "Chapter Tools" in the reference bar > click on "Programs and Yearbook." This page contains the Yearbook Requirements, as well as helpful formatting resources and the new Yearbook Upload Link. Please note the 50 MB file size limit.

The deadline for uploading your chapter yearbook is OCTOBER 1, 2015. Printed copies are still allowed for distribution to chapter members, councils, and please save one to bring to Convention 2016 for display in the Exhibits room.
